The HAT committee is proud to announce that **we have achieved Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) status**. This has occurred after a robust assessment of HAT by both the Department of Foreign Affairs, and the Australian Taxation Office.

The change means that **if you wish to make a gift or donation over \$2 you will be able to claim a tax deduction**. It also means that companies and high net worth individuals will be more likely to donate to HAT projects.

It has been a long journey but we are very excited about this achievement, and we believe that this is the beginning of a new wonderful chapter for HAT and the communities we serve.
