The Health Australia & Tanzania (HAT) Committee is delighted to officially welcome Martin Gould as our new Committee Member.

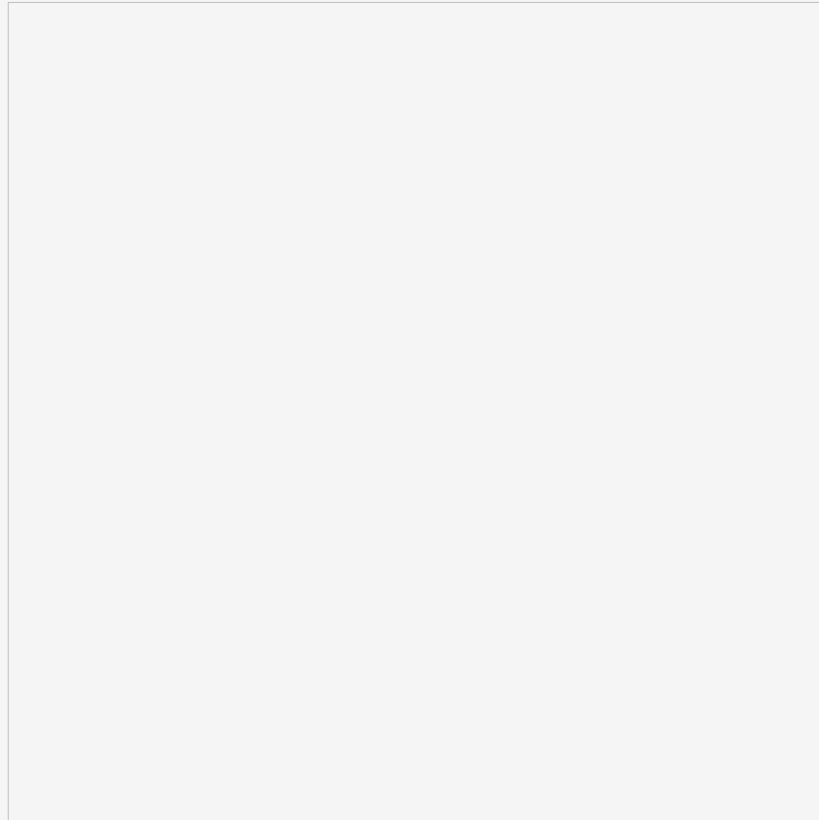
